The boat was built for Hasan Ali Bayar is indeed a living legend of the Turkish shipbuilding industry and one of the most respected figures in the design and construction of high-end wooden vessels.

To understand his importance, one must see him not only as an engineer, but as a *Master Builder* who elevated the traditional Turkish gulet (schooner) technique to the level of international superyachts.

Here's why he's so renowned:

1. The Architect of the Gulet "Renaissance"

Before figures like Bayar, Turkish gulets were robust but rustic fishing or transport vessels. He pioneered the application of modern naval engineering and luxury design to these boats. His work allowed gulets to move beyond being mere local vessels and compete in the world's most exclusive ports (such as Monaco or Saint-Tropez).

2. Founder and Soul of Su Marine

Although he has collaborated with various shipyards, his name is inextricably linked to *Su Marine* (in Tuzla, Istanbul). Under his technical direction, the shipyard became a hallmark of quality. If a boat bore Bayar's signature, it was known that:

- * The *laminated wood hull* was virtually indestructible.

- * The lines were elegant and timeless.

- * The sailing was technical, not just aesthetic.

3. The "Nazzen" Project (His Personal Masterpiece)

As you mentioned, the *Princess Nazan Deniz* (now Entre Cielos) of 2004 is his most emblematic project because he made it "for home."

- * *Innovation:* In an era when many wooden boats were heavy, he designed a 32-meter sailboat that was agile and refined.

- * *Recognition:* That vessel put Turkey on the map in the nautical world, demonstrating that they could build ships that rivaled those of the Italians or the Dutch.

4. His Status in Turkey

In the Turkish nautical world, Hasan Ali Bayar is seen as a mentor. He has trained generations of engineers and shipwrights. His reputation is that of a man with an impeccable work ethic and an absolute perfectionist.

> *Note on his health: The fact that he had to sell the Nazzen (his personal dream) due to his health was a widely discussed event in nautical circles in Istanbul and Tuzla, as the ship was considered his architectural "child." He hadn't finished it, and the current owner bought it and asked him to add very refined finishes for his private use.

Today, his boats (such as the Doruk Reis-A, the Princess Nazan Denise/Entre Cielos or the Meteoro) are still highly sought after in the second-hand market because they are considered "author's works" that do not lose value over time.
